A little leaven leaveneth the whole



For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:




Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, **Cursed is every one that hangeth** on a tree:


That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.


The curse of the law is poverty, sin and premature death.
