Nothing will accelerate our spiritual growth more than feeding on the Word of God

2 Timothy 3:16

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness

2 Timothy 3:17

That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

We must base our lives on the Word of God

Unreliable sources of authority

1. Culture

You can rely on culture to rule your life

Just because everybody is doing it doesn't make it the right thing to do.

Exodus 23:2

Thou shalt not follow a multitude to do evil; neither shalt thou speak in a cause to decline after many to wrest judgment:

Isaiah 5:20

Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter!

The only way to be relevant all the time is to be eternally minded by continually feeding on God's Word

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

2. Tradition

Matthew 15:6

And honour not his father or his mother, he shall be free. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition.

3. Reason

Reason reliess on our own intelect

Proverbs 16:25

And said, O LORD God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? and rulest not thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand is there not power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee?

4. Emotions

Just because you felt like it was God doesn't always mean it was

Judges 21:25

In those days there was no king in Israel: every man did that which was right in his own eyes.
