2 Corinthians 10:12

For we dare not class ourselves or compare ourselves with those who commend themselves. But they, measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise.

2 Corinthians 10:13

<u>Joshua 18:3</u>

<u>Joshua 18:4</u>

The proper disposition of the past

<u>Joshua 1:2</u>

"Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them -- the children of Israel.

Deuteronomy 34:4

Then the LORD said to him, "This is the land of which I swore to give Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, `I will give it to your descendants.' I have caused you to see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there."

Be strong and of good courage

1. Because of His promise

<u>Joshua 1:6</u>

"Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them.

2. By living in God's principles and patterns



"Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go.

<u>Joshua 1:8</u>

"This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.
