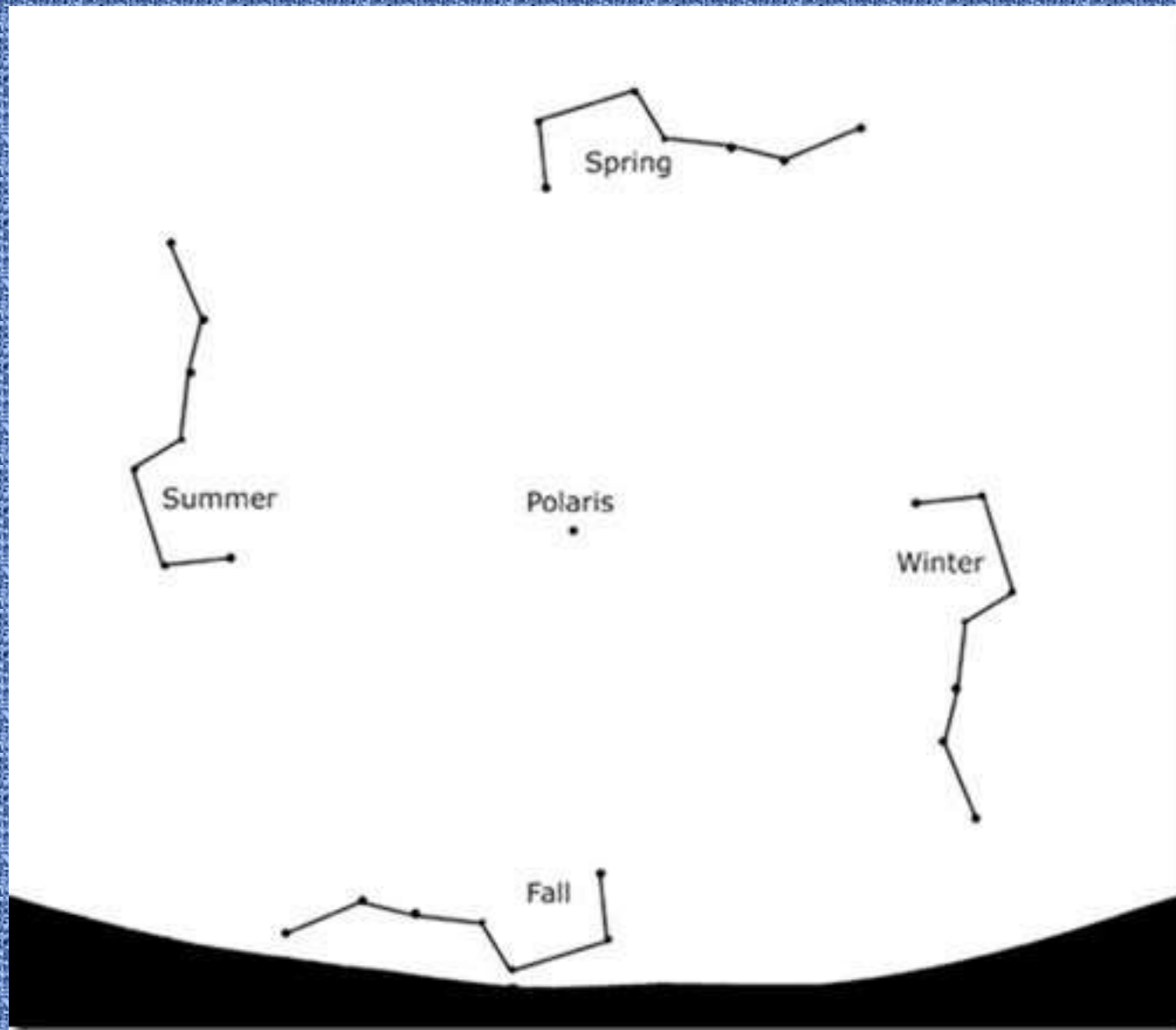

**Seek ye the LORD
while he may be
found, call ye upon
him while he is near:**

Isaiah 55:7

**Let the wicked forsake his way,
and the unrighteous man his
thoughts: and let him return
unto the LORD, and he will have
mercy upon him; and to our
God, for he will abundantly
pardon.**

Isaiah 55:8

**For my thoughts are not
your thoughts, neither
are your ways my ways,
saith the LORD.**

Isaiah 55:9

**For as the heavens are
higher than the earth, so
are my ways higher than
your ways, and my
thoughts than your
thoughts.**

2 Peter 3:9

2 Peter 3:10

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

2 Peter 3:11

Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,

2 Peter 3:12

**Looking for and hasting unto
the coming of the day of God,
wherein the heavens being
on fire shall be dissolved,
and the elements shall melt
with fervent heat?**

2 Peter 3:13

Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

2 Peter 3:14

Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.

2 Peter 3:15

**And account that the
longsuffering of our Lord is
salvation; even as our beloved
brother Paul also according to
the wisdom given unto him hath
written unto you;**

2 Peter 3:16

As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.

Hebrews 5:5

So also Christ glorified not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee.

Hebrews 5:6

**As he saith also in
another place, Thou art
a priest for ever after
the order of
Melchisedec.**

Hebrews 5:7

Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;

Hebrews 5:8

**Though he were a Son,
yet learned he
obedience by the things
which he suffered;**

Hebrews 5:9

**And being made perfect,
he became the author of
eternal salvation unto
all them that obey him;**

Hebrews 5:10

**Called of God an high
priest after the order of
Melchisedec.**

Hebrews 5:11

Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull of hearing.

Hebrews 7:1

For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;

Hebrews 7:2

To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;

Hebrews 7:3

**Without father, without mother,
without descent, having neither
beginning of days, nor end of
life; but made like unto the Son
of God; abideth a priest
continually.**

Hebrews 7:4

**Now consider how great
this man was, unto
whom even the
patriarch Abraham gave
the tenth of the spoils.**

Hebrews 7:5

And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham:

Hebrews 7:6

**But he whose descent is not
counted from them
received tithes of
Abraham, and blessed him
that had the promises.**

Hebrews 7:7

**And without all
contradiction the less
is blessed of the
better.**

John 8:56

**Your father Abraham
rejoiced to see my
day: and he saw it,
and was glad.**

John 8:57

**Then said the Jews
unto him, Thou art
not yet fifty years old,
and hast thou seen
Abraham?**

John 8:58

**Jesus said unto them,
Verily, verily, I say
unto you, Before
Abraham was, I am.**

John 8:59

Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.

John 10:26

**But ye believe not,
because ye are not of
my sheep, as I said
unto you.**

John 10:27

**My sheep hear my
voice, and I know
them, and they follow
me:**

John 10:28

And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

John 10:29

**My Father, which gave them
me, is greater than all; and
no man is able to pluck
them out of my Father's
hand.**

John 10:30

Promise #3:

John 17:20

**Neither pray I for these
alone, but for them also
which shall believe on
me through their word;**

John 17:21

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

John 17:22

**And the glory which thou
gavest me I have given
them; that they may be
one, even as we are
one:**

John 17:23

I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
