Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God,

2 Timothy 1:9

**who has saved us and called us
with a holy calling, not
according to our works, but
according to His own purpose
and grace which was given to
us in Christ Jesus before time
began,**

2 Timothy 1:10

**but has now been revealed by
the appearing of our Savior
Jesus Christ, who has
abolished death and brought
life and immortality to light
through the gospel,**

2 Timothy 1:11

**to which I was
appointed a preacher,
an apostle, and a
teacher of the
Gentiles.**

2 Timothy 1:12

For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

2 Timothy 1:13

Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:14

**That good thing which
was committed to
you, keep by the Holy
Spirit who dwells in
us.**

2 Timothy 1:15

This you know, that all those in Asia have turned away from me, among whom are Phygellus and Hermogenes.

2 Timothy 1:16

**The Lord grant mercy to
the household of
Onesiphorus, for he
often refreshed me, and
was not ashamed of my
chain;**

2 Timothy 1:17

**but when he arrived in
Rome, he sought me
out very zealously
and found me.**

2 Timothy 1:18

The Lord grant to him that he may find mercy from the Lord in that Day -- and you know very well how many ways he ministered to me at Ephesus.

2 Timothy 2:1

**You therefore, my
son, be strong in
the grace that is
in Christ Jesus.**

1 Corinthians 2:1

And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God.

1 Corinthians 2:2

**For I determined not to
know anything
among you except
Jesus Christ and Him
crucified.**

1 Corinthians 2:3

**I was with you in
weakness, in fear,
and in much
trembling.**

1 Corinthians 2:4

And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power,

1 Corinthians 2:5

**that your faith
should not be in the
wisdom of men but
in the power of God.**

Romans 4:19

And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb.

Romans 4:20

He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God,

Romans 4:21

**and being fully
convinced that what
He had promised He
was also able to
perform.**

Romans 4:22

**And therefore "it
was accounted to
him for
righteousness."**

Romans 4:23

**Now it was not
written for his sake
alone that it was
imputed to him,**

Romans 4:24

**but also for us. It shall
be imputed to us who
believe in Him who
raised up Jesus our
Lord from the dead,**

Romans 4:25

**who was delivered up
because of our
offenses, and was
raised because of our
justification.**

Romans 5:1

**Therefore, having been
justified by faith, we
have peace with God
through our Lord
Jesus Christ,**

Shake off the
shame...

Do the dirt
dance

Ministry
misidentification
leads to ministry
malpractice...

testimony it
simply means you
are living in
unbelief...

If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.

1 Corinthians 14:28

But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.

1 Corinthians 14:29

**Let two or three
prophets speak,
and let the others
judge.**

1 Corinthians 14:30

But if anything is revealed to another who sits by, let the first keep silent.

1 Corinthians 14:31

**For you can all
prophecy one by one,
that all may learn and
all may be
encouraged.**

1 Corinthians 14:32

**And the spirits of
the prophets are
subject to the
prophets.**

1 Corinthians 14:33

**For God is not the
author of confusion
but of peace, as in all
the churches of the
saints.**

we are here to make
disciples of all nations, if
you are called to lead
then follow to leadership,
if you are called to follow,
then lead others to
follow!!
