**And when they were
come to the multitude,
there came to him a
certain man, kneeling
down to him, and
saying,**

Matthew 17:15

Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

Matthew 17:16

**And I brought him
to thy disciples,
and they could
not cure him.**

thanksgiving;**

When you speak
to the mountain,
you must have a
life of prayer.

Lack of prayer
in private equals
ineffective prayers
in public.

Luke 18:1

**And he spake a
parable unto them to
this end, that men
ought always to pray,
and not to faint;**

Luke 18:2

**Saying, There was in a
city a judge, which
feared not God,
neither regarded
man:**

**And there was a widow
in that city; and she
came unto him,
saying, Avenge me of
mine adversary.**

And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man;
