John 1:29

**The next day John seeth
Jesus coming unto him,
and saith, Behold the
Lamb of God, which
taketh away the sin of
the world.**

Matthew 11:2

**Now when John had
heard in the prison
the works of Christ,
he sent two of his
disciples,**

Matthew 11:3

**And said unto him, Art
thou he that should
come, or do we look
for another?**

Matthew 11:4

**Jesus answered and
said unto them, Go
and shew John again
those things which ye
do hear and see:**

Matthew 11:5

**The blind receive their sight,
and the lame walk, the lepers
are cleansed, and the deaf
hear, the dead are raised up,
and the poor have the gospel
preached to them.**

Matthew 11:6

**And blessed is he,
whosoever shall
not be offended in
me.**

Mark 13:31

**Heaven and earth
shall pass away:
but my words shall
not pass away.**

And the angel answering said unto him, I am Gabriel, that stand in the presence of God; and am sent to speak unto thee, and to shew thee these glad tidings.

And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because thou believest not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season.

**And the people waited
for Zacharias, and
marvelled that he
tarried so long in the
temple.**

Luke 1:22

And when he came out, he could not speak unto them: and they perceived that he had seen a vision in the temple: for he beckoned unto them, and remained speechless.

Luke 1:23

**And it came to pass, that,
as soon as the days of
his ministration were
accomplished, he
departed to his own
house.**

Luke 1:24

**And after those days
his wife Elisabeth
conceived, and hid
herself five months,
saying,**

**Thus hath the Lord dealt
with me in the days
wherein he looked on
me, to take away my
reproach among men.**

Luke 1:26

**And in the sixth month
the angel Gabriel was
sent from God unto a
city of Galilee, named
Nazareth,**

Luke 1:27

To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.

Luke 1:28

And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly favoured, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women.

Luke 1:29

**And when she saw him,
she was troubled at his
saying, and cast in her
mind what manner of
salutation this should
be.**

Luke 1:30

**And the angel said
unto her, Fear not,
Mary: for thou hast
found favour with
God.**

Luke 1:31

**And, behold, thou shalt
conceive in thy
womb, and bring
forth a son, and shalt
call his name JESUS.**

Luke 1:32

He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

**And he shall reign over
the house of Jacob
for ever; and of his
kingdom there shall
be no end.**

Luke 1:34

**Then said Mary unto
the angel, How shall
this be, seeing I
know not a man?**

Luke 1:35

And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

Luke 1:36

**And, behold, thy cousin
Elisabeth, she hath also
conceived a son in her
old age: and this is the
sixth month with her,
who was called barren.**

Luke 1:37

**For with God
nothing shall be
impossible.**

Luke 1:38

**And Mary said, Behold
the handmaid of the
Lord; be it unto me
according to thy word.
And the angel departed
from her.**

Luke 1:39

And Mary arose in those days, and went into the hill country with haste, into a city of Juda;

Luke 1:40

**And entered into
the house of
Zacharias, and
saluted Elisabeth.**

Luke 1:40

**And it came to pass, that,
when Elisabeth heard the
salutation of Mary, the
babe leaped in her womb;
and Elisabeth was filled
with the Holy Ghost:**

Matthew 14:1

**At that time Herod
the tetrarch heard
of the fame of
Jesus,**

Matthew 14:2

**And said unto his servants,
This is John the Baptist; he
is risen from the dead; and
therefore mighty works do
shew forth themselves in
him.**

Matthew 14:3

For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

Matthew 14:4

**For John said unto
him, It is not
lawful for thee to
have her.**

Matthew 14:5

**And when he would have
put him to death, he
feared the multitude,
because they counted
him as a prophet.**

But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod.

Matthew 14:7

**Whereupon he
promised with an
oath to give her
whatsoever she
would ask.**

Matthew 14:8

**And she, being before
instructed of her
mother, said, Give me
here John Baptist's
head in a charger.**

Matthew 14:9

**And the king was sorry:
nevertheless for the
oath's sake, and them
which sat with him at
meat, he commanded it
to be given her.**

Matthew 14:10

**And he sent, and
beheaded John
in the prison.**

Matthew 14:11

**And his head was
brought in a charger,
and given to the damsel:
and she brought it to her
mother.**
