**And a certain
woman, which had
an issue of blood
twelve years,**

Mark 5:26

And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,

Romans 10:17

**So then faith cometh
by hearing, and
hearing by the word
of God.**

Matthew 24:35

**Heaven and earth
shall pass away, but
my words shall not
pass away.**

**He sent his word, and
healed them, and
delivered them from
their destructions.**

Mark 5:27

**When she had heard of
Jesus, came in the
press behind, and
touched his garment.**

Mark 5:28

**For she said, If I
may touch but his
clothes, I shall be

And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.

**And he looked

done this thing.**

**But the woman fearing
and trembling, knowing
what was done in her,
came and fell down
before him, and told him
all the truth.**

Mark 5:34

**And he said unto her,
Daughter, thy faith hath
made thee whole; go in
peace, and be whole of
thy plague.**

She was
nameless & chained
& now
she is claimed and
named, Daughter.

Mark 10:46

And they came to Jericho: and as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging.

Mark 10:47

And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me.
