## *Failing Where It Counts*

The young man behind bars in the county jail had just recently accepted Christ as his personal Saviour. He began to tell me his story of how he had committed several serious crimes and how soon afterwards he was converted. His newly-found relationship with God had prompted him to set right his affairs with men. He had traveled more than a thousand miles to confess his crimes.

As we talked during one of the infrequent visiting periods, he told me about his background. He had grown up near a Baptist church where he had attended Sunday school for several years as a Junior and Intermediate. He talked fondly of those years.

"During those years in Sunday school no one ever told me how to be saved. Why?"

I was hard pressed for an answer.

After a long silence he answered his own question. "I would not be here now—and the man I killed would be alive." After a long pause he continued, "Why didn't someone tell me how to be saved?"

I went on my way with his question haunting me, reminding me of souls I had failed.

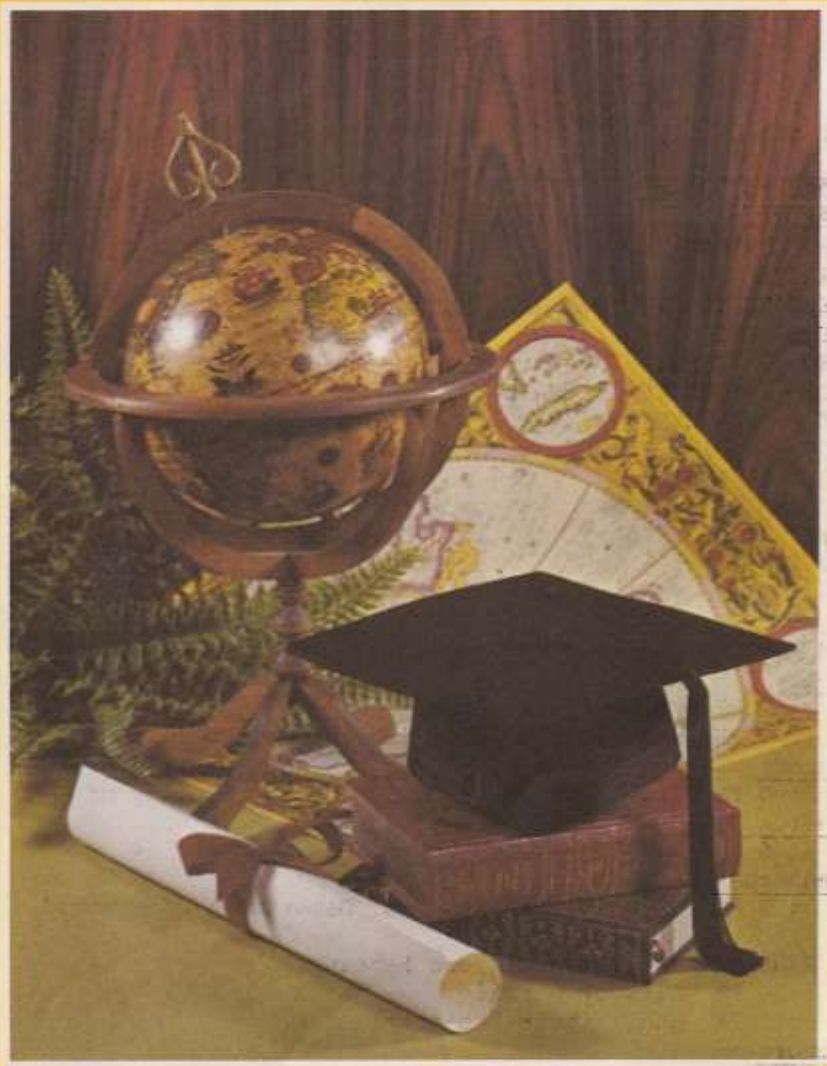

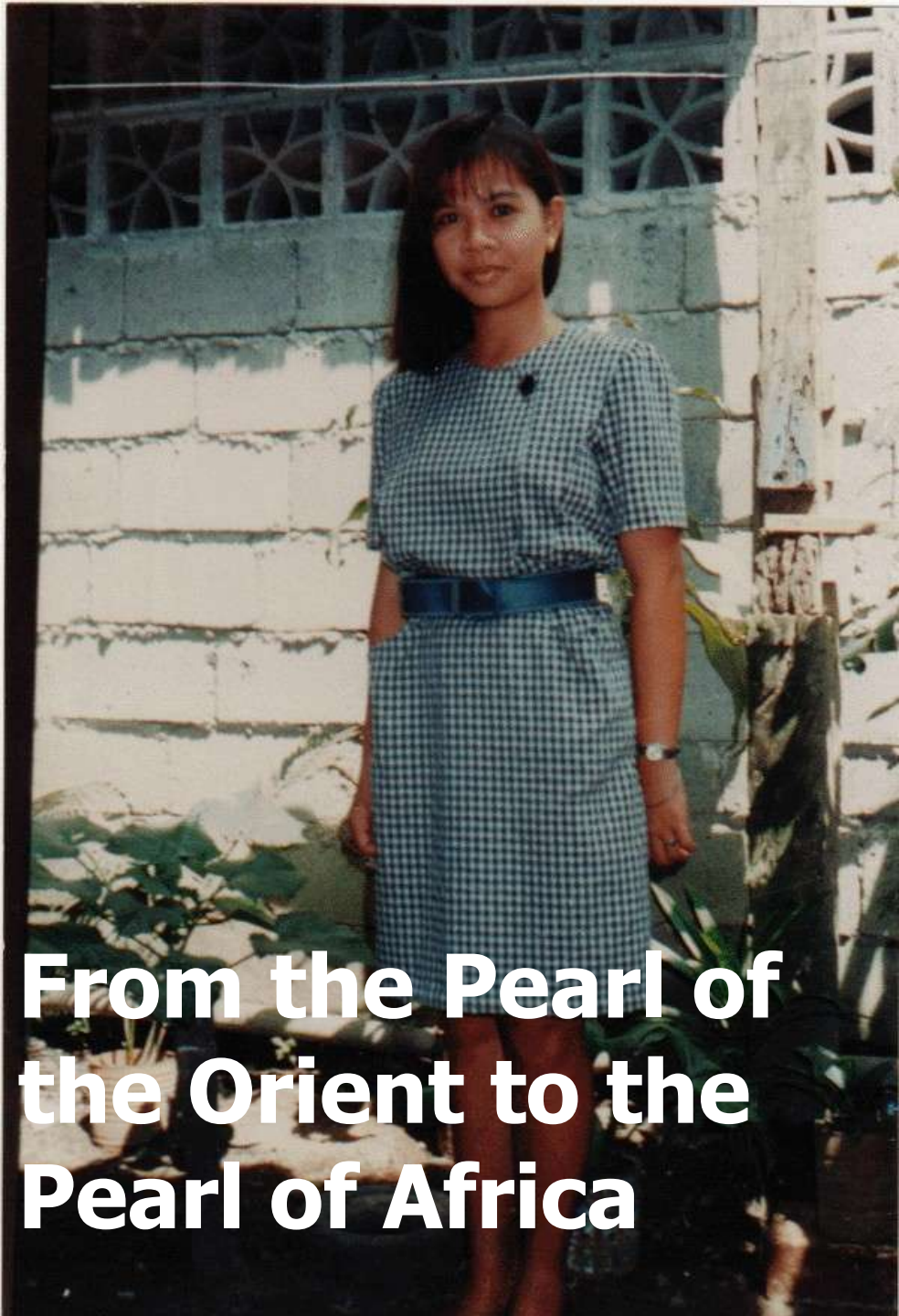
