Christ Jesus which are at
Philippi, with the bishops and
deacons:

Grace and peace
can change any
day

Philippians 1:4

Always in every prayer of mine for
you all making request with joy,

Pray about
everything

Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

Be confident God
will finish
anything he
starts

Philippians 1:12

But I would ye should understand,
brethren, that the things which
happened unto me have fallen
out rather unto the furtherance
of the gospel;

You are now
positioned for
greater victories
because of what
you have gone
through

Job 4:3
