# I Sam 25:25

"Please, let not my lord regard this scoundrel Nabal. For as his name is, so is he: Nabal is his name, and folly is with him. But I, your maidservant, did not see the young men of my lord whom you sent.



# I Sam 25:26

"Now therefore, my lord, as the LORD lives and as your soul lives, since the LORD has held you back from coming to bloodshed and from avenging yourself with your own hand, now then, let your enemies and those who seek harm for my lord be as Nabal.



I Sam 25:27

"And now this present  
which your maidservant  
has brought to my lord,  
let it be given to the  
young men who follow  
my lord.

# I Sam 25:28

"Please forgive the trespass of your maidservant. For the LORD will certainly make for my lord an enduring house, because my lord fights the battles of the LORD, and evil is not found in you throughout your days.

I Sam 25:32

Then David said to  
Abigail: "Blessed is the  
LORD God of Israel,  
who sent you this day  
to meet me!

# I Sam 25:33

"And blessed is your advice  
and blessed are you,  
because you have kept me  
this day from coming to  
bloodshed and from  
avenging myself with my  
own hand.

# I Sam 25:34

"For indeed, as the LORD God of Israel lives, who has kept me back from hurting you, unless you had hastened and come to meet me, surely by morning light no males would have been left to Nabal!"



# I Sam 25:35

So David received from her hand what she had brought him, and said to her, "Go up in peace to your house. See, I have heeded your voice and respected your person."

# Gen 32:20

"and also say, `Behold, your servant Jacob is behind us.'"

For he said, "I will appease him with the present that goes before me, and afterward I will see his face; perhaps he will accept me."





Gen 32:21

So the present went  
on over before him,  
but he himself lodged  
that night in the  
camp.

# II Chron. 9:8

"Blessed be the LORD your God, who delighted in you, setting you on His throne to be king for the LORD your God! Because your God has loved Israel, to establish them forever, therefore He made you king over them, to do justice and righteousness."

stones.


# II Chron. 9:11

# I Sam 18:1

Now when he had finished speaking to Saul, the soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul.



1 Sam 18:2

Saul took him that day,  
and would not let him  
go home to his  
father's house  
anymore.

I Sam 18:3

Then Jonathan and  
David made a  
covenant, because he  
loved him as his own  
soul.



1 Sam 18:4

And Jonathan took off  
the robe that was on  
him and gave it to  
David, with his armor,  
even to his sword and  
his bow and his belt.

I Sam 19:1

Now Saul spoke to  
Jonathan his son and  
to all his servants,  
that they should kill  
David;



# I Sam 19:2

but Jonathan, Saul's son,  
delighted greatly in David.  
(19:2) So Jonathan told David,  
saying, "My father Saul seeks  
to kill you. Therefore please be  
on your guard until morning,  
and stay in a secret place and  
hide.



# I Sam 19:3

"And I will go out and stand beside my father in the field where you are, and I will speak with my father about you. Then what I observe, I will tell you."

# I Sam 20:30

Then Saul's anger was aroused against Jonathan, and he said to him, "You son of a perverse, rebellious woman! Do I not know that you have chosen the son of Jesse to your own shame and to the shame of your mother's nakedness?"

# I Sam 20:31

"For as long as the son of Jesse lives on the earth, you shall not be established, nor your kingdom. Now therefore, send and bring him to me, for he shall surely die."

I Sam 20:32

And Jonathan answered  
Saul his father, and said  
to him, "Why should he  
be killed? What has he  
done?"

I Sam 20:33

Then Saul cast a spear at  
him to kill him, by  
which Jonathan knew  
that it was determined  
by his father to kill  
David.



# I Sam 20:34

So Jonathan arose from the table in fierce anger, and ate no food the second day of the month, for he was grieved for David, because his father had treated him shamefully.





I Sam 20:35

And so it was, in the morning, that Jonathan went out into the field at the time appointed with David, and a little lad was with him.



I Sam 20:36

Then he said to his lad,  
"Now run, find the  
arrows which I shoot."  
As the lad ran, he shot  
an arrow beyond him.

# I Sam 20:37

When the lad had come to the place where the arrow was which Jonathan had shot, Jonathan cried out after the lad and said, "Is not the arrow beyond you?"

# I Sam 20:38

And Jonathan cried out after the lad, "Make haste, hurry, do not delay!" So Jonathan's lad gathered up the arrows and came back to his master.



1 Sam 20:39

But the lad did not  
know anything. Only  
Jonathan and David  
knew of the matter.

I Sam 20:40

Then Jonathan gave his  
weapons to his lad,  
and said to him, "Go,  
carry them to the  
city."



# I Sam 20:41

As soon as the lad had gone,  
David arose from a place  
toward the south, fell on his  
face to the ground, and bowed  
down three times. And they  
kissed one another; and they  
wept together, but David more  
so.

# I Sam 20:42

Then Jonathan said to David, "Go in peace, since we have both sworn in the name of the LORD, saying, 'May the LORD be between you and me, and between your descendants and my descendants, forever.'" So he arose and departed, and Jonathan went into the city.

# II Sam. 9:1

Now David said, "Is there still anyone who is left of the house of Saul, that I may show him kindness for Jonathan's sake?"
