**And a certain  
woman, which had  
an issue of blood  
twelve years,**



# Mark 5:26

**And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,**

# **Mark 5:27**

**When she had heard of  
Jesus, came in the press  
behind, and touched his  
garment.**



# **Mark 5:28**

**For she said, If I may  
touch but his clothes, I  
shall be whole.**

Come as you  
are & allow  
God to  
change you.

contend for  
the move of  
God.**



We must

# **Mark 5:29**

**And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague.**

# **Mark 5:30**

**And Jesus, immediately  
knowing in himself that virtue  
had gone out of him, turned  
him about in the press, and said,

multitude thronging thee,  
and sayest thou, Who  
touched me?**
