Consistency is the key.

Safeguard #10:

Pray the Word over your home and children daily.

Romans 15:5 (AMPL)

Now may the God Who gives the power of patient endurance (steadfastness) and Who supplies encouragement, grant you to live in such mutual harmony and such full sympathy with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus,

Romans 15:6 (AMPL)

That together you may <unanimously> with united hearts and one voice, praise and glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah).

Romans 15:7 (AMPL)

Welcome and receive <to your hearts> one another, then, even as Christ has welcomed and received

you, for the glory of God.

Romans 13:13 (AMPL)

Let us live and conduct ourselves honorably and becomingly as in the <open light of> day, not in reveling (carousing) and drunkenness, not in immorality and debauchery (sensuality and licentiousness), not in quarreling and jealousy.

Proverbs 5:15 (AMPL)

Drink waters out of your own cistern <of a pure marriage relationship>, and fresh running waters out of your own well.

Proverbs 5:16 (AMPL)

Should your offspring be dispersed abroad as water brooks in the

streets?

Proverbs 5:17 (AMPL)

Confine yourself to your own wife> let your children be for you alone, and not the children of

strangers with you.

Proverbs 5:18 (AMPL)

Let your fountain <of human life> be blessed <with the rewards of fidelity>, and rejoice in the

wife of your youth.

Proverbs 5:19 (AMPL)

Let her be as the loving hind and pleasant doe <tender, gentle, attractive>--let her bosom satisfy you at all times, and always be transported with delight in her love.

The two will become one flesh.

Colossians 2:2 (AMPL)

<For my concern is> that their hearts may be braced (comforted, cheered, and encouraged) as they are knit together in love, that they may come to have all the abounding wealth and blessings of assured conviction of understanding, and that they may become progressively more intimately acquainted with and may know more definitely and accurately and thoroughly that mystic secret of God, <which is> Christ (the **Anointed One).**

Philippians 1:27 (AMPL)

Only be sure as citizens so to conduct yourselves <that> your manner of life <will be> worthy of the good news (the Gospel) of Christ, so that whether I <do> come and see you or am absent, I may hear this of you: that you are standing firm in united spirit and purpose, striving side by side and contending with a single mind for the faith of the glad tidings (the Gospel).

1 Corinthians 13:4 (AMPL)

Love endures long and is patient and kind; love never is envious nor boils over with jealousy, is not boastful or vainglorious, does not display itself haughtily.

1 Corinthians 13:5 (AMPL)

It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) and does not act unbecomingly. Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights or its own way, for it is not self-seeking; it is not touchy or fretful or resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it <it pays no attention to a suffered wrong>.

1 Corinthians 13:6 (AMPL)

It does not rejoice at injustice and unrighteousness, but rejoices when right and truth prevail.

1 Corinthians 13:7 (AMPL)

Love bears up under anything and everything that comes, is ever ready to believe the best of every person, its hopes are fadeless under all circumstances, and it endures everything <without weakening>.

1 Corinthians 13:8 (AMPL)

Love never fails < never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end>. As for prophecy (the gift of interpreting the divine will and purpose), it will be fulfilled and pass away; as for tongues, they will be destroyed and cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away <it will lose its value and be superseded by truth>.
