Luke 18:1 AMP

Now Jesus was telling the disciples a parable to make the point that at all times they ought to pray and not give up and lose heart

Luke 18:2 AMP

saying, “In a certain city there was a judge who did not fear God and had no respect for man.

Luke 18:3 AMP

There was a [desperate] widow in that city and she kept coming to him and saying, 'Give me justice and legal protection from my adversary.'

Luke 18:4 AMP

**For a time he would not;
but later he said to
himself, 'Even though I
do not fear God nor
respect man,**

Luke 18:5 AMP

yet because this widow continues to bother me, I will give her justice and legal protection; otherwise [a]by continually coming she [will be an intolerable annoyance and she] will wear me out.””

Luke 18:6 AMP

**Then the Lord said,
“Listen to what the
unjust judge says!**

Luke 18:7 AMP

And will not [our just] God defend and avenge His elect [His chosen ones] who cry out to Him day and night? Will He delay [in providing justice] on their behalf?

Luke 18:8 AMP
