Matthew 17:19

Then the disciples came to Jesus in private and asked, "Why couldn't we drive it out?"

Matthew 17:20

He replied, "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

Faith knows no difference regardless of the need

It doesn't matter how big the mountain is, it takes the same faith

The vitality and value of faith requires a lifestyle

You can't live any way you want and have mountain moving faith.

2. Faith must fight
