
and blessed be your discernment, and blessed be you, who have kept me this day from bloodshed and from avenging myself by my own hand.

When we walk in the anointing, the devil will come against you to defeat that anointing


<u>1 John 4:4NASB</u>

You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.


The strongest way to defeat the devil is on your knees before God




Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works themselves.
