**Now unto him that is able
to do exceeding
abundantly above all that
we ask or think, according
to the power that worketh
in us,**

**And they were both
righteous before God,
walking in all the
commandments and

**And they had no child,
because that Elisabeth
was barren, and they
both were now well
stricken in years.**

Luke 1:8

**And it came to pass, that
while he executed the
priest's office before
God in the order of his
course,**

According to the custom of the priest's office, his lot was to burn incense when he went into the temple of the Lord.

**And the whole
multitude of the
people were praying
without at the time of
incense.**

Luke 1:11

**And there appeared
unto him an angel of
the Lord standing on
the right side of the
altar of incense.**

Luke 1:12

**And when Zacharias
saw him, he was
troubled, and fear
fell upon him.**

Luke 1:13

But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.

Luke 1:14

**And thou shalt have
joy and gladness;
and many shall
rejoice at his birth.**

Luke 1:15

For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.

Luke 1:16

**And many of the
children of Israel
shall he turn to the
Lord their God.**

Luke 1:17

And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

Luke 1:18

And Zacharias said unto the angel, Whereby shall I know this? for I am an old man, and my wife well stricken in years.

Luke 1:19

And the angel answering said unto him, I am Gabriel, that stand in the presence of God; and am sent to speak unto thee, and to shew thee these glad tidings.

And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because thou believest not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season.

And when he came out, he could not speak unto them: and they perceived that he had seen a vision in the temple: for he beckoned unto them, and remained speechless.

his wife Elisabeth
conceived, and hid
herself five months,
