# **Luke 2:25**

**And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him.**

**The full story of

FINISHED work  
of the cross**

**The finished  
work of the  
cross is where  
the power is**

# **Hebrews 4:1**

**Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise  
being left us of entering into his  
rest, any of you should seem to  
come short of it.**

# **Hebrews 4:2**

**For unto us was the gospel preached,  
as well as unto them: but the word  
preached did not profit them, not  
being mixed with faith in them that  
heard it.**

# **Hebrews 4:3**

**For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.**



# **Hebrews 4:4**

**For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.**

# **Hebrews 4:5**

**And in this place again, If they shall  
enter into my rest.**

# **Hebrews 4:6**

**Seeing therefore it remaineth that  
some must enter therein, and they  
to whom it was first preached  
entered not in because of unbelief:**

# **Hebrews 4:7**

**Again, he limiteth a certain day,  
saying in David, To day, after so long  
a time; as it is said, To day if ye will  
hear his voice, harden not your  
hearts.**

# **Hebrews 4:8**

**For if Jesus had given them rest, then  
would he not afterward have  
spoken of another day.**

# **Hebrews 4:9**

**There remaineth therefore a rest to  
the people of God.**

# **Hebrews 4:10**

**For he that is entered into his rest, he  
also hath ceased from his own  
works, as God did from his.**

# **Hebrews 4:11**

**Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.**



# **Hebrews 4:12**

**For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.**

in His rest have  
ceased from  
their struggles**

**It is difficult for  
faith to work  
without the  
rest of God**

**The rest of God  
is believing  
that God  
knows what He  
is doing**

**God knows

changed**

**God's rest is the  
end result of what  
God had figured out  
before the  
foundation of the  
world**

frustration**

**Rest is a  
faith choice  
that we have  
to enter into**

**It is God's  
will that we  
live anxiety  
and fear free**

**Stop letting  
some one or  
some thing  
continually  
upset you**

**There are many  
levels of rest  
but you have to  
start  
somewhere**

**You have to  
work the Word  
if the Word is  
going to work**

**You have to let  
go of your ways  
and let God  
take control**

**The rest of  
God must  
become a  
priority**
